6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to required teacher units  
7 under the public school foundation program."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 14.17.050(h) is amended to read:

10 (h) This schedule of allowable number of teacher units  
11 is only for use in determining allotments under the public  
12 school foundation program, and does not prohibit a district  
13 from hiring a greater number of teachers to be paid from its  
14 own funds. If a district operates any school with less than  
15 301 pupils in a remote and isolated area, the state Board of  
16 Education may order that school to be treated as a separate  
17 district for the purpose of determining the allowable number  
18 of teacher units the district is entitled to for that school  
19 under (d) of this section.
