6 For an Act entitled: "An Act to extend the boundaries of the
7 City of Valdez by annexation; and providing
8 an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. PURPOSE. As a result of shifts in the land mass
11 upon which the City of Valdez is situated, which were caused by
12 the earthquake and seismic wave of March 27, 1964, it is neces-
13 sary to relocate the City of Valdez. The purpose of this Act is
14 to extend the corporate limits of the City of Valdez by annexa-
15 tion to include land upon which the City of Valdez will be
16 relocated.

17 * Sec. 2. AREA TO BE ANNEXED. The following described land
18 containing approximately 8,640 acres, is annexed to the City of
19 Valdez, Alaska:

20 "Beginning at the northwest corner of Section
21 19, Township 8 South, Range 6 West, Copper River
22 Meridian; thence south 80.00 chains more or less
23 to the southwest corner of said Section 19; thence
24 west 79.56 chains more or less to the northwest
25 corner of Section 25, Township 8 South, Range 7
26 West, Copper River Meridian; thence south along
27 the west boundary of Sections 25 and 36, Township
28 8 South, Range 7 West, Copper River Meridian 123
29 chains more or less to a point of intersection

with the line of mean low low water of Valdez Arm; thence easterly along the line of mean low low water to its intersection with the south boundary of Section 3, Township 9 South, Range 6 West, Copper River Meridian; thence east along the south boundary of Sections 3 and 2, Township 9 South, Range 6 West, Copper River Meridian 123 chains more or less to the southeast corner of said Section 2; thence north along the east boundary of said Section 2 80.0 chains more or less to the northeast corner of said Section 2; thence west 31.15 chains more or less to the southeast corner of Section 35, Township 8 South, Range 6 West, Copper River Meridian; thence north along the east boundary of said Section 35, 80.0 chains more or less to the northeast corner of said Section 35; thence west 79.78 chains more or less along the north boundary of said Section 35 to the northwest corner of said Section 35; thence north 40.0 chains to a point on the east boundary of Section 27, Township 8 South, Range 6 West, Copper River Meridian; thence west 159.34 chains more or less to a point on the east boundary of Section 29, Township 8 South, Range 6 West, Copper River Meridian; thence north 40.0 chains more or less, along the east boundary of Section 29 to the northeast corner of said Section 29; thence west 39.78 chains to a point on the south boundary of Section 20, Township 8 South, Range 6 West, Copper River

Meridian; thence north 80.0 chains more or less to a point on the north boundary of said Section 20; thence west 119.01 chains more or less to the northwest corner of Section 19, Township 8 South, Range 6 West, Copper River Meridian, the point of beginning."

* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
