6 For an Act entitled: "An Act to extend the boundaries of the
7 City of Seward by annexation; and providing
8 an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. PURPOSE. As a result of shifts in the land
11 mass upon which the City of Seward is situated, which were
12 caused by the earthquake and seismic wave of March 27, 1964, it
13 is necessary to relocate a part of the City of Seward on lands
14 which are not presently located within the corporate limits of
15 the City of Seward. The purpose of this Act is to extend the
16 corporate limits of the City of Seward by annexation to include
17 land upon which a part of the City of Seward will be relocated.

18 * Sec. 2. AREA TO BE ANNEXED. The following described land
19 is annexed to the City of Seward, Alaska:

20 "From a point of beginning at a point where the
21 Seward base line intersects the SW corner of Section
22 34, thence north to the NW corner of Section 22,
23 Township 1N, thence East to the NE corner of Section
24 22, thence North to the NW corner of Section 14 R1W,
25 thence East to the NE corner of Section 14 R1W,
26 thence North to the NW corner of Section 1, thence East
27 to the NE corner of Section 1, thence South to the
28 SE corner of Section 1, thence East to the NE corner
29 of Section 7 R1E, thence South to the SE corner of

Section 18 R1E, thence West to the NE corner of
Section 24 T1N, thence South to the SE corner of
Section 1, T1S, thence West to the present city
limits of the City of Seward, thence NW around the
present limits of the City of Seward to the point
of beginning."

* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage
and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
