3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
4 THIRD LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION
5 Relating to a time limit for the
6 duration of the first regular
7 session of the Third Legislature.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CON-
9 CURRING:

10 WHEREAS, the length of a regular session of the Legislature
11 is limited only by the time it takes the Legislature to accomplish
12 its necessary business; and

13 WHEREAS, the Legislature has found in the first four sessions
14 as a state legislature that the time actually necessary to accom-
15 plish the essential business of an annual session is predicated
16 on the hours of work and diligence employed by members and com-
17 mittees; and

18 WHEREAS, with a daily salary operating cost of \$3,000 it be-
19 hooves the Legislature to accomplish its business with dispatch
20 in the interest of both economy and efficiency;

21 BE IT RESOLVED that the Third Legislature in first regular
22 session will proceed to accomplish its essential work with dis-
23 patch and diligence and arrange its daily sessions and committee
24 work on a time schedule which requires completion of its work and
25 adjournment on or by the 45th day, March 13, 1963.
