5 Relating to shuttle ferry service
6 for the isolated communities of
7 Southeastern Alaska.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CON-
9 CURRING:

10 WHEREAS the small isolated communities in Southeastern Alaska
11 are not joined by an inexpensive means of public transportation
12 with one another and the major population and transportation
13 centers of the area; and

14 WHEREAS if the isolated communities of Southeastern Alaska
15 are to realize their potential and their citizens are to be
16 afforded an opportunity to participate fully in the development of
17 the state, ready access to neighboring communities, cities, and
18 transportation centers must be available to them all; and

19 WHEREAS regular shuttle ferry service linking the small
20 isolated communities of Southeastern Alaska and her highways and
21 cities would go a long way toward granting these communities the
22 equal partnership they deserve in the progress of Alaska;

23 BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested
24 to instruct the Department of Public Works to make a feasibility
25 and cost study on providing shuttle ferry service for all smaller
26 Southeastern Alaska communities not now served by the main ferry
27 line and report the findings of the study to the Second Session
28 of the Third Legislature when it convenes in 1964.
