2 SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 7  
3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA  
4 THIRD LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to construction of a  
6 breakwater at Kake to protect the  
7 small boat harbor.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CON-  
9 CURRING:

10 WHEREAS, in addition to vessels which are moored at the  
11 city of Kake the year-round, a considerably larger fishing fleet  
12 must be accommodated during the height of the fishing season; and

13 WHEREAS the city of Kake has a harbor facility which does  
14 not provide a safe harbor for even the permanent fleet; and

15 WHEREAS the weather conditions and heavy seas do consider-  
16 able damage to the boats moored at the small boat harbor; and

17 WHEREAS, with installation of a breakwater, favorable con-  
18 ditions for boat moorage would exist;

19 BE IT RESOLVED that the Corps of Engineers, U.S. Army, is  
20 respectfully urged to program the necessary surveys for the con-  
21 struction of a breakwater to protect the small boat harbor at  
22 Kake and report its findings and recommendations to the Congress  
23 at the earliest opportunity in order that construction funds can  
24 be appropriated; and be it
