5 Relating to a study on the use,
6 form, and disposition of executive
7 orders having the force of law.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CON-
9 CURRING:

10 WHEREAS the Constitution of the State of Alaska authorizes
11 the governor to issue executive orders making changes in the
12 organization of executive agencies or the assignment of functions
13 in those agencies for efficient administration; and

14 WHEREAS when these executive orders change the law and have
15 the force of law they must be submitted to the legislature; and

16 WHEREAS, if not disapproved, these executive orders become
17 effective at a later date and are noted in the Alaska Statutes;
18 and

19 WHEREAS executive orders having the force of law are of
20 vital concern to all three coordinate and equal branches of the
21 government;

22 BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council is directed to
23 study and report on the use, form and effect of executive orders
24 on existing law and the feasibility of having executive orders
25 submitted in the form of specific amendments to the statutes and
26 their inclusion in the supplements to the Alaska Statutes as
27 amendments to the law.
