SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 16

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

THIRD LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

Relating to the use of the former  
Providence Hospital facility in  
Anchorage for a juvenile security  
and rehabilitation center.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CON-  
CURRING:

WHEREAS Anchorage, the state's largest city, is in dire need  
of a suitable facility for security custody and rehabilitation of  
juveniles; and

WHEREAS the former Providence Hospital in downtown Anchorage  
is now available for use as a public or private institution; and

WHEREAS a pending Senate bill provides for bonding for a  
state office building in Anchorage and the amount requested is  
beyond that which is needed for the building;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested to  
investigate the possibility of purchasing the former Providence  
Hospital facility and its conversion to a security and rehabilita-  
tion center for juveniles; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that any bonding authorized by the Legisla-  
ture and the voters for the construction and maintenance of a state  
office building in Anchorage be used in part for the purchase and  
conversion of the present hospital facility into a state juvenile  
security and rehabilitation center in connection with any office  
building construction.
