5 Relating to a substantive revision of
6 occupational and professional board
7 statutes.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CON-
9 CURRING:

10 WHEREAS occupational and professional licensing statutes,
11 if properly drawn, provide a substantial protection to the public
12 but if improperly drawn, burden the people with unnecessary regu-
13 lation and deprive persons of their constitutional right to en-
14 gage in the occupation of their choice; and

15 WHEREAS the Legislative Council's 1963 Report on Occupation-
16 al and Professional Licensing Boards reports 10 areas of licensing
17 law that may need substantive revision; and

18 WHEREAS each of the 14 licensing board statutes have pro-
19 visions that fall into one or more of those areas; and

20 WHEREAS, before corrections to the statutes can be intelli-
21 gently made, more information on the practices of and dangers to
22 the public inherent in the 14 licensed occupations and professions
23 is necessary;

24 BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council is directed to
25 gather information at hearings on activities in licensed occupa-
26 tions and professions, and on the public interest to be protected
27 by licensing, and to prepare a substantive revision of the boards
28 statutes for submission to the 1964 session of the Legislature.
