5 Relating to a study on holding
6 centers and a maximum study and
7 treatment center for juveniles.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CON-
9 CURRING:

10 WHEREAS, there has been considerable discussion of the need
11 for a state maximum security study and treatment center and sub-
12 sidiary holding and temporary treatment centers for juveniles; and

13 WHEREAS, legislation authorizing the administration of these
14 types of facilities is now pending in the Legislature; and

15 WHEREAS, it is essential that the Legislature have all per-
16 tinent information on hand before a program of this importance and
17 financial impact is approved;

18 BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is requested to direct the
19 Department of Health and Welfare, with the cooperation of the
20 Division of Buildings, to make a feasibility study on the need
21 a state maximum security study and treatment center and for sub-
22 sidiary holding and temporary centers for juveniles and submit its
23 findings to the Legislature in January of 1964. The report should
24 include the type of facilities needed; suggested locations;
25 number of juveniles to be accommodated in each center; the cost of
26 securing each facility; the estimated annual operating costs of
27 each facility; and suggested methods of financing, including issu-
28 ance of nonprofit corporation or general obligation bonds.
