5 Relating to a study of the feasibility
6 of a sabbatical leave program for state
7 employees.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CON-
9 CURRING:

10 WHEREAS, a sabbatical leave program for teachers has been
11 established by the Legislature; and

12 WHEREAS, it is recognized in business and in government that
13 sabbatical leave programs for professional and technical employees
14 benefit both the employer and the employee by making possible the
15 improvement of skills through refresher courses and contact with
16 current developments in given fields; and

17 WHEREAS, the number of professional and technical persons
18 employed and needed by the state suggests the need for such
19 refresher and improvement opportunities through a state employee
20 sabbatical leave program;

21 BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council is directed and
22 the Governor is requested to direct the Department of Adminis-
23 tration to cooperate in making a study of the administrative and
24 fiscal feasibility of a sabbatical leave program for state
25 employees and to jointly report their findings and recommendations
26 to the Fourth Legislature in 1965.
