5 Relating to the late Charles D. Jones.

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CON-
7 CURRING:

8 WHEREAS, since the last meeting of the Legislature, Charles
9 D. Jones of Nome, a pioneer Alaskan and pioneer member of the
10 Alaska Legislature, has been taken in death; and

11 WHEREAS the Honorable Charles D. Jones -

12 First came to Nome in 1900 to engage in mining and con-
13 tinued his interest in that field until his death;

14 Served as United States Marshal at Nome for a decade;

15 Served in the First Territorial Legislature in 1913;

16 Returned to the Legislature in 1953 to serve as Presi-
17 dent of the Senate and continued to serve as a member through
18 the 22nd Territorial Legislature; and

19 Was a member of Igloo No. 1 of the Pioneers of Alaska
20 and served as state president of that organization; and

21 WHEREAS the late Charles D. Jones truly epitomized those
22 pioneer virtues of perseverance, industry, and public service which
23 are so highly regarded by pioneer and new Alaskans;

24 BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature, for the people of Alaska
25 by this resolution speaks in praise of its former colleague and
26 expresses to the family of the Honorable Charles D. Jones their
27 deepest sentiments of sympathy for their loss and the loss of the
28 State of Alaska.
