6 feasibility of ferry service to  
7 Kake, Angoon and Hoonah.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CON-  
9 CURRING:

10 WHEREAS, inauguration and expansion of the state marine high-  
11 way system continues to prove its merit and benefit to the  
12 communities served and the state in general; and

13 WHEREAS, the expansion of the marine highway system to serve  
14 more and smaller communities is inevitable; and

15 WHEREAS, the island villages of Kake, Angoon and Hoonah  
16 remain isolated from the flow of ferry traffic connecting princi-  
17 pal mainland and island ports in Southeastern Alaska;

18 BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is earnestly requested to  
19 direct the Division of Marine Transportation of the Department of  
20 Public Works to make a study of the need for, and benefits and  
21 cost of connecting the villages of Kake, Angoon and Hoonah with  
22 the main Southeast Alaska Ferry System and to report its findings  
23 and recommendations to the Legislature in January 1965.
