5 Relating to a study of range laws  
6 in Alaska.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CON-  
8 CURRING:

9 WHEREAS, the infant industry of beef cattle raising offers  
10 great promise of developing into an important segment of Alaska's  
11 economy; and

12 WHEREAS, good and economically sound grazing conditions are  
13 vital to the development of the industry; and

14 WHEREAS, unclear or unsound law relating to the control of  
15 grazing cattle will tend to increase the cost of cattle raising  
16 without benefit to anyone; and

17 WHEREAS, the present law in Alaska is not always clear, and  
18 in many respects of very questionable soundness and propriety for  
19 present conditions;

20 BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council undertake a study  
21 of present conditions in and current laws relating to the cattle  
22 raising industry in Alaska, and present a report to the First  
23 Session of the Fourth Legislature, together with any legislation  
24 which may be necessary to attain a sound and fair balancing of  
25 interests.
