2 SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 23
3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
4 THIRD LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Relating to the prohibition against the
6 sale of king salmon taken in Cook Inlet
7 as an incident to fishing for other
8 species of salmon.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
10 CONCURRING:

11 WHEREAS, the Alaska Board of Fish and Game has adopted 5
12 Alaska Administrative Code, Chapter 1, Section 109.05 which in
13 part prohibits the sale of king salmon taken in Cook Inlet as an
14 incident to commercial fishing for other species of salmon; and

15 WHEREAS, the earthquake of March 27, 1964, has adversely
16 affected the economy of the Cook Inlet area; and

17 WHEREAS, the permitted sale of king salmon, taken in Cook
18 Inlet as an incident to commercial fishing for other species of
19 salmon, would have a beneficial effect upon the economy in Cook
20 Inlet; and

21 WHEREAS, the benefit to the Cook Inlet area economy result-
22 ing from the permitted sale of king salmon taken in Cook Inlet as
23 an incident to fishing for other species of salmon will be con-
24 siderable, while prohibition of the sale of king salmon caught as
25 an incident to fishing for other species of salmon serves no
26 conservation purpose;

27 BE IT RESOLVED that pursuant to the power vested in the
28 Alaska legislature by AS 44.62.320, 5 Alaska Administrative Code,
29 Chapter 1, Section 109.05 be and is hereby annulled; and be it

1 FURTHER RESOLVED that by annulling 5 Alaska Administrative
2 Code, Chapter 1, Section 109.05 it is intended that only the
3 prohibition against the sale of incidentally caught king salmon
4 be abolished. It is the desire of the legislature that all pro-
5 visions of 5 Alaska Administrative Code, Chapter 1, Section 109.05
6 other than the provision prohibiting the sale of incidentally
7 caught king salmon which are annulled by this concurrent resolu-
8 tion be re-enacted as a part of the Alaska Administrative Code.
