4 THIRD LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Proposing an amendment to the state  
6 constitution to provide for an uneven  
7 membership for both houses of the  
8 legislature.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 Section 1, Article II, Constitution of the State of Alaska is  
11 amended to read:

12 "Section 1. The legislative power of the state is vested  
13 in a legislature consisting of a senate with a membership of  
14 twenty-one and a house of representatives with a membership of  
15 forty-one. The apportionment of the senate and house of rep-  
16 resentatives determined by the proclamation of the governor on  
17 December 7, 1961 continues in effect until the reapportionment  
18 of 1971. Pending the 1971 reapportionment the twenty-first  
19 member of the senate and the twenty-first member of the house  
20 of representatives shall be nominated and elected at large in  
21 conformity with the state election code and necessary regula-  
22 tions for the at-large election made by the secretary of  
23 state." and

24 BE IT RESOLVED that this proposed amendment be placed before  
25 the voters of the state at the next state-wide election in con-  
26 formity with Section 1, Article XIII, Constitution of the State of  
27 Alaska and the state election code.
