5 Relating to the need for a branch
6 post office in the Muldoon Road -
7 Nunaka Valley - De Barr Vista commun-
8 ity near Anchorage.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 WHEREAS there is no post office facility in the Muldoon Road -
11 Nunaka Valley - De Barr Vista community near Anchorage; and

12 WHEREAS the community contains some 10,000 persons and approxi-
13 mately 3,000 school-age children; and

14 WHEREAS the nearest post office to the community is at the
15 Anchorage International Airport, 13 miles or more from the commun-
16 ity; and

17 WHEREAS the necessity of traveling that distance during the
18 severe winter months works a substantial hardship on the people of
19 the area; and

20 WHEREAS there are enough people in the community to justify the
21 establishment of a branch post office;

22 BE IT RESOLVED that the Honorable J. Edward Day, Postmaster
23 General of the United States, be respectfully urged to establish
24 a branch post office in the Muldoon Road - Nunaka Valley - De Barr
25 Vista community near Anchorage; and be it

26 FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be sent to the
27 members of the Alaska delegation in Congress.
