BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS, it is the understanding of the Legislature of the

State of Alaska that the United Nations organization is contem-

11

plating the relocation of its headquarters site; and

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska has and is willing to make

13

available a suitable site to the United Nations should it decide

14

to relocate its headquarters; and

15

WHEREAS, the state-owned Point Woronzof site near Anchorage,

16

the crossroads of the modern world and international air transpor-

17

tation hub, could be made available to the United Nations for

18

relocation purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Point Woronzof site is suited both in size,

20

location, proximity to facilities, and in beauty for the present

21

and future needs of the United Nations headquarters;

BE IT RESOLVED that the State of Alaska offers to the United

23

Nations through the U. S. Representative to the United Nations,

the Honorable Adlai E. Stevenson, the state-owned Point Woronzof

25

site near Anchorage, Alaska, as the future headquarters for the

United Nations.
