2 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 35

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 THIRD LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Proposing an amendment to the state
6 constitution to provide that an
7 act rejected by referendum may not
8 be re-enacted within two years
9 after its rejection.

10 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 Section 6, Article XI, Constitution of the State of Alaska,
12 is amended to read:

13 "Section 6. If the majority of votes cast on the pro-
14 position favor its adoption, the initiated measure is
15 enacted. If a majority of the votes cast on the proposition
16 favor the rejection of an act referred, it is rejected.
17 The secretary of state shall certify the election returns.
18 An initiated law becomes effective ninety days after certi-
19 fication, is not subject to veto, and may not be repealed by
20 the legislature within two years of its effective date.
21 It may be amended at any time. An act rejected by refer-
22 endum is void thirty days after certification and may not
23 be re-enacted by the legislature within two years after its
24 rejection. Additional procedures for the initiative and re-
25 ferendum may be prescribed by law." and

26 BE IT RESOLVED that this proposed amendment be placed before
27 the voters of the state at the next statewide election in con-
28 formity with Section 1, Article XIII, Constitution of the State
29 of Alaska, and the election laws of the state.
