8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS, fundamental knowledge about one of Alaska's greatest
10 resources, the fishery, is vital to intelligent utilization of
11 the resource; and

12 WHEREAS, this fundamental knowledge is equally important to
13 fishermen and canneries in planning day-to-day and season-to-
14 season operations; and

15 WHEREAS, accurate knowledge of the life cycles and migration
16 patterns of fish is also necessary to maintaining treaty obliga-
17 tions concerning protection and harvesting of the resource; and

18 WHEREAS, the Fisheries Research Institute of the University
19 of Washington is making significant contributions to salmon re-
20 search and to forecasting salmon runs in Alaska waters, thus
21 making possible the more beneficial use of this resource by the
22 people and the state;

23 BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of the State of Alaska
24 expresses its grateful appreciation for the contributions of the
25 Fisheries Research Institute of the University of Washington; and
