Urging the Bureau of Indian

Affairs to provide cold storage

facilities in the villages.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS, many of the villages of Western Alaska within the

10

area of jurisdiction of the Bureau of Indian Affairs have co-

11

operative stores for the benefit of the residents; and

12

WHEREAS, it is the main purpose of these cooperative stores

13

to make foodstuffs available to the local population at prices

14

compatible with their economic circumstances; and

15

WHEREAS, this purpose could be advanced further by providing

16

cold storage facilities in connection with the cooperative stores

17

in order to preserve the game and fish harvested locally which

18

for lack of such facilities often spoils;

19

BE IT RESOLVED that the Bureau of Indian Affairs is urgently

20

requested to make provision for cold storage facilities for

21

villages having cooperative stores; and be it

22

FURTHER RESOLVED, that copies of this resolution be sent to

23

the Honorable Stewart L. Udall, Secretary of the Interior; the

24

Honorable Philleo Nash, Commissioner of Indian Affairs; the

25

Honorable Robert L. Bennett, Area Director, Bureau of Indian

26

Affairs; and the members of the Alaska Delegation in Congress.
