7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS, in response to a call at 3:30 a.m. on February 23,  
9 1964, Officer Gene Moody of the Juneau Police Department found a  
10 young woman struggling in the waters of Gastineau Channel; and

11 WHEREAS, Officer Moody immediately dived into the channel,  
12 swam 25 yards through the frigid waters to reach the woman, pulled  
13 her back to a piling, and held her head above water until further  
14 assistance could be rendered; and

15 WHEREAS, this heroic rescue, performed at great personal  
16 risk, saved the life of the woman; and

17 WHEREAS, Officer Moody's conduct was an outstanding example  
18 of service to a community by its law enforcement officers;

19 BE IT RESOLVED that the members of the Legislature do hereby  
20 commend Officer Gene Moody for his bravery and selfless devotion  
21 to duty.
