

1 IN THE SENATE BY THE STATE AFFAIRS COMMITTEE  
2 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 64  
3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA  
4 THIRD LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION  
5 Proposing an amendment to Article  
6 IV, The Judiciary, of the Consti-  
7 tution of the State of Alaska.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 That the following amendment to Section 15, Article IV, of  
10 the Constitution of the State of Alaska is proposed:

11 "Section 15. The supreme court shall make and promul-  
12 gate rules governing the administration of all courts. It  
13 shall make and promulgate rules governing practice and pro-  
14 cedure in civil and criminal cases in all courts. The  
15 legislature, by law, may delete, change, and add to rules  
16 governing the administration of all courts and rules govern-  
17 ing practice and procedure in civil and criminal cases in all  
18 courts [THESE RULES MAY BE CHANGED BY THE LEGISLATURE BY TWO-  
19 THIRDS VOTE OF THE MEMBERS ELECTED TO EACH HOUSE]."; and

20 BE IT RESOLVED that this proposed amendment be placed before  
21 the voters of the state at the next statewide election in confor-  
22 mity with Section 1, Article XIII, Constitution of the State of  
23 Alaska and the state election code.
