5 Relating to the designation of Point
6 Barrow as a national monument; and
7 the construction of a road to Point
8 Barrow.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

10 WHEREAS Point Barrow is the northernmost landmark of North
11 America; and

12 WHEREAS this geographical significance could be one of
13 Alaska's most interesting tourist attractions; and

14 WHEREAS because of its unique location Point Barrow ought to
15 be, but is not presently, designated as a national monument; and

16 WHEREAS there is presently no convenient means of transporta-
17 tion to Point Barrow from Barrow;

18 BE IT RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Interior request the
19 National Park Service to officially designate Point Barrow as a
20 national monument and that the Secretary of Commerce request the
21 Bureau of Public Roads to construct a road from Barrow, Alaska to
22 Point Barrow, Alaska; and be it

23 FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be sent to the
24 Honorable John F. Kennedy, President of the United States; the
25 Honorable John A. Carver, Jr., Assistant Secretary of Interior for
26 Public Land Management; the Honorable Clarence D. Martin, Jr.,
27 Undersecretary for Transportation; the Honorable Conrad L. Wirth,
28 Director of the National Park Service; and the members of the
29 Alaska delegation in Congress.
