8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

9 WHEREAS the several states of the Union have taken the  
10 initiative in fishery research and development; and

11 WHEREAS the off-shore fishery resources of the United States  
12 are the proper concern of both the federal and state governments;  
13 and

14 WHEREAS the federal government has an obligation to encourage  
15 and assist in state research and development programs; and

16 WHEREAS a bold program to assist the states in their efforts  
17 to develop their fishery resources is essential to the proper  
18 conservation and utilization of this basic resource;

19 BE IT RESOLVED that the Congress is respectfully requested to  
20 give favorable consideration to S. 627 introduced by the Honorable  
21 E. L. Bartlett, U.S. Senator from Alaska, a bill to promote state  
22 commercial fishery research and development projects; and be it

23 FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be transmitted  
24 to the Honorable Lyndon B. Johnson, Vice President of the United  
25 States and President of the Senate; the Honorable John W.  
26 McCormack, Speaker of the House of Representatives; the Honorable  
27 Warren G. Magnuson, Chairman of the Senate Committee on Commerce;  
28 the Honorable Herbert Bonner, Chairman of the House Committee on
