2 SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 17
3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
4 THIRD LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION
5 Relating to the building of sea-
6 walls at Unalakleet and Kotzebue.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

8 WHEREAS, the cities of Kotzebue and Unalakleet are located
9 on federal land and also have federal installations located there;
10 and

11 WHEREAS, both cities are located in areas where there is
12 little or no protection against the sea in the event of severe
13 storms, which have in the past inflicted severe damage; and

14 WHEREAS, the existing seawall at Kotzebue is almost destroyed
15 and life and property will remain in danger until these cities are
16 adequately protected by seawalls;

17 BE IT RESOLVED that the Corps of Engineers, United States
18 Army is respectfully urged to construct the necessary seawalls at
19 Unalakleet and Kotzebue, designed to protect the lives and proper-
20 ty of the people living there and at the federal installations;

24 Olin Johnston, Chairman, Committee on Public Works; the Honorable

26 Col. Kenneth T. Sawyer, District Engineer, Corps of Engineers,
27 U. S. Army; and the members of the Alaska Delegation in Congress.
