8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

9 WHEREAS the several states of the Union have taken the
10 initiative in fishery research and development; and

11 WHEREAS the off-shore fishery resources of the United States
12 are the proper concern of both the federal and state governments;
13 and

14 WHEREAS the federal government has an obligation to encourage
15 and assist in state research and development programs; and

16 WHEREAS a bold program to assist the states in their efforts
17 to develop their fishery resources is essential to the proper
18 conservation and utilization of this basic resource;

19 BE IT RESOLVED that the Congress is respectfully requested to
20 give favorable consideration to H.R. 3738 introduced by the Honor-
21 able Ralph J. Rivers, U. S. Representative from Alaska, a bill to
22 promote state commercial fishery research and development projects
23 and be it

24 FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be transmitted
25 to the Honorable Lyndon B. Johnson, Vice President of the United
26 States and President of the Senate; the Honorable John W. McCormack,
27 Speaker of the House of Representatives; the Honorable Warren G.
