4 THIRD LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to the defective and inade-
6 quate water supply of the villages of
7 Chenega and Tatitlek.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

9 WHEREAS the defective and inadequate water supply of the
10 villages of Chenega and Tatitlek is jeopardizing the general
11 health and welfare of the citizens of these villages; and

12 WHEREAS Tatitlek has a new school which is placing an increased
13 burden on an already inadequate plumbing and sewage facility and
14 on the limited water supply; and

15 WHEREAS the villages have asked assistance from the Alaska
16 Native Health Service in Anchorage; and

17 WHEREAS the Alaska Native Health Service has not acted upon
18 their request; and

19 WHEREAS the situation is getting worse with the passage of
20 time and increasing population in both areas;

21 BE IT RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Department of Health
22 Education, and Welfare and the Surgeon General, United States
23 Public Health Service, are respectfully urged to study and assist
24 in correcting the defective and inadequate water supply before a
25 great health problem arises; and be it

26 FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be sent to the
27 Honorable Anthony J. Celebrezze, Secretary of Health, Education,
28 and Welfare; the Honorable Luther L. Terry, Surgeon General,
