BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

WHEREAS the defective and inadequate water supply of the

11

villages of Larsen Bay, Chenega and Tatitlek is jeopardizing the

12

general health and welfare of the citizens of these villages; and

13

WHEREAS Tatitlek has a new school which is placing an increased

14

burden on an already inadequate plumbing and sewage facility and

15

on the limited water supply; and

16

WHEREAS the villages have asked assistance from the Alaska

17

Native Health Service in Anchorage; and

18

WHEREAS the Alaska Native Health Service has not acted upon

19

their request; and

20

WHEREAS the situation is getting worse with the passage of

21

time and increasing population in both areas;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Department of Health,

23

Education, and Welfare and the Surgeon General, United States

24

Public Health Service, are respectfully urged to study and assist

25

in correcting the defective and inadequate water supply before a

26

great health problem arises; and be it
