10 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

11 WHEREAS, Anchorage, the state's largest city, is in dire need  
12 of a suitable facility for office space; and

13 WHEREAS, the former Providence Hospital in downtown Anchorage  
14 is now available for use as a public or private institution; and

15 WHEREAS, there is a bonding issue of \$5,000,000 being con-  
16 sidered for state office building construction; and

17 WHEREAS, the pending Senate bill provides for bonding for  
18 state office buildings in Anchorage and the amount requested is  
19 beyond that which is needed for the buildings;

20 BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested to  
21 investigate the possibility of purchasing the former Providence  
22 Hospital facility and its conversion to an office building; and be  
23 it

24 FURTHER RESOLVED that any bonding authorized by the Legisla-  
25 ture and the voters for the purchase and construction of state  
26 office buildings in Anchorage be used in part for the purchase and  
27 conversion of the present hospital facility into a state office  
28 building in connection with any office building construction.
