5 Relating to legislation enabling the
6 establishment of a legal townsite for
7 the Juneau Native village.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

9 WHEREAS, there is now no provision in the federal law on
10 native townsites and disposition of lots for villages built on
11 tidelands; and

12 WHEREAS, the Juneau Native village is built on tidelands and
13 is now ineligible for a native townsite status and the disposition
14 of lots and the residents cannot get title to their homes; and

15 WHEREAS, the Honorable Ralph J. Rivers, U. S. Representative
16 in the Congress from Alaska has introduced H.R. 2047 to enable the
17 Juneau Native village to become a townsite;

18 BE IT RESOLVED that the Honorable Stewart L. Udall, Secretary
19 of the Interior, and the members of the Alaska delegation in
20 Congress are urged to give active support for H.R. 2047 in order
21 that the Juneau Native village may establish a townsite and obtain
22 title to their homes.
