BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

WHEREAS, there is now no provision in the federal law on

11

native townsites and disposition of lots for villages built on

12

tidelands; and

13

WHEREAS, the Juneau Native village is built on tidelands and

14

is now ineligible for a native townsite status and the disposition

15

of lots and the residents cannot get title to their homes; and

16

WHEREAS, the Honorable E. L. Bartlett and the Honorable Ernest

17

Gruening have introduced S. 247 to enable the Juneau native village

18

to become a townsite; and

19

WHEREAS, the Honorable Ralph J. Rivers, U. S. Representative

20

in the Congress from Alaska has introduced H. R. 2047 to enable

21

the Juneau Native village to become a townsite;

22

BE IT RESOLVED that the Honorable Stewart L. Udall, Secretary

23

of the Interior, and the members of the Alaska delegation in

24

Congress are urged to give active support for H. R. 2047 and S. 247

25

in order that the Juneau Native village may establish a townsite

26

and obtain title to their homes.
