5 Relating to the placement of a
6 public health nurse at Hoonah.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

8 WHEREAS, the city of Hoonah and environs has a population of
9 900 persons; and

10 WHEREAS, the city is without a resident trained nurse and all
11 medical assistance must be flown in from Juneau or residents
12 needing medical care must fly to Juneau for treatment; and

13 WHEREAS, the air service is both infrequent and expensive,
14 thus adding to the health hazard and the expense of needed medical
15 attention; and

16 WHEREAS, the placement by the U. S. Public Health Service of
17 a public health nurse at Hoonah would benefit both the health and
18 the economic well being of the community;

19 BE IT RESOLVED that the Secretary of Health, Welfare, and
20 Education and the Surgeon General, United States Public Health
21 Service, are respectfully urged to station a public health nurse
22 at Hoonah to provide essential basic health services to the resi-
23 dents of the area; and be it

24 FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be sent to
25 the members of the Alaska delegation in Congress.
