3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 THIRD LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to the over-conservation of  
6 Alaskan natural resources.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

8 WHEREAS, influential conservationist groups from outside the  
9 state continue to press for further land withdrawals in Alaska  
10 for recreational areas and game refuges; and

11 WHEREAS, these groups are again directing their attention to  
12 a withdrawal of Admiralty Island in Southeast Alaska for national  
13 park purposes; and

14 WHEREAS, Alaska is already covered with a variety of federal  
15 land withdrawals and reservations; and

16 WHEREAS, the proposal for Admiralty Island is another example  
17 of the continuing bottling up of Alaska's natural resources with-  
18 out reference to the economic well-being of the state and the broad  
19 interests of the nation; and

20 WHEREAS, the resources on the public lands of Alaska should  
21 be inventoried and a multiple-use plan developed before further  
22 withdrawals are made;

23 BE IT RESOLVED that the Honorable Orville L. Freeman,  
24 Secretary of Agriculture; the Honorable Stuart L. Udall, Secretary  
25 of the Interior; and the members of the Alaska delegation in  
26 Congress are respectfully requested to see that Admiralty Island  
27 and the other timber and mineral resource areas of Alaska are not  
28 withdrawn in the name of conservation without a thorough inventory  
29 of the resources affected and consideration of the economic
