BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

WHEREAS Anchorage, the state's largest city, is in dire need

11

of a suitable facility for security custody and rehabilitation of

12

juveniles; and

WHEREAS the former Providence Hospital in downtown Anchorage

14

is now available for use as a public or private institution; and

15

WHEREAS a pending Senate bill provides for bonding for a

16

state office building in Anchorage and the amount requested is

17

beyond that which is needed for the building;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested to

19

investigate the possibility of purchasing the former Providence

20

Hospital facility and its conversion to a security and rehabilita-

21

tion center for juveniles; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that any bonding authorized by the Legisla-

23

ture and the voters for the construction and maintenance of a

24

state office building in Anchorage be used in part for the purchase

25

and conversion of the present hospital facility into a state

26

juvenile security and rehabilitation center in connection with any

27

office building construction.
