5 Relating to the placement of mountain
6 sheep in the Kigluaik and Darby
7 Mountains.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

9 WHEREAS the Kigluaik and Darby Mountains located on the
10 Seward Peninsula on either side of Nome do not have any mountain
11 sheep; and

12 WHEREAS these mountain areas are eminently suited as a habitat
13 for mountain sheep; and

14 WHEREAS the placement of mountain sheep in these areas would
15 eventually enhance the mountains as an attraction to the tourist
16 and hunter and thereby benefit the area;

17 BE IT RESOLVED that the Honorable Stewart L. Udall, Secretary
18 of the Interior, and the Honorable Clarence L. Pautzke, Commission
19 er of the Fish and Wildlife Service are respectfully requested to
20 take the necessary action to have mountain sheep placed in the
21 Kigluaik and Darby Mountains of western Alaska; and be it

22 FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be directed
23 to the members of the Alaska delegation in Congress and the Com-
24 missioner of Fish and Game, State of Alaska.
