6 at the New York World's Fair.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

8 WHEREAS Alaska, in the eyes of the Nation and the world, in-
9 creasingly symbolizes the last frontier of our western civiliza-
10 tion; and

11 WHEREAS Alaska, with its exhibit at the New York World's Fair
12 is in a position to emphasize this change in the visitors'
13 traditional concept of the West; and

14 WHEREAS Alaska, in addition to its scenic wonders and its
15 pioneers' achievements, has a rich heritage of native design and
16 arts;

17 BE IT RESOLVED that Alaska's outstanding architectural crea-
18 tion, the Tlingit community house be the theme of Alaska's exhibi-
19 tion building at the New York World's Fair, and be it

20 FURTHER RESOLVED that, as a boost to Alaska's economy and as
21 an advertisement of Alaska's wood products, as a saving in the
22 funds appropriated for Alaska's participation at the Fair, and as
23 an encouragement and gesture of appreciation to our few surviving
24 Native woodcarvers and other Native craftsmen, the planned struc-
25 tures be pre-fabricated in Alaska to the fullest extent possible
26 and assembled in New York, making full use of the advertising value
27 of this plan and procedure.
