6 McNealy as official representative of the
7 Alaska State Senate to Japan.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

9 WHEREAS, the Alaska State Senate recognizes the importance
10 of increasing trade relations with the nation of Japan to aid the
11 economy of the state; and

12 WHEREAS, the Senate desires first hand knowledge at a high
13 policy level on expanding export-import trade which may aid in
14 future legislation for the development and sale of our natural
15 resources; and

16 WHEREAS, Senate Majority Leader, Robert J. McNealy, is
17 traveling to Japan, at his own expense, on the adjournment of this
18 legislative session to meet with government officials and
19 industrial leaders to study present and future trade prospects;

20 BE IT RESOLVED that Senator Robert J. McNealy is hereby
21 designated as the official representative of the Alaska State
22 Senate to the nation of Japan for the sole purpose of making
23 preliminary studies for expanding trade relations and to report
24 back his findings to the Senate at the convening of the 1964
25 session of the Third Legislature.
