BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has a road-building
10 program intended to improve conditions in and communication be-
11 tween the villages of Western Alaska; and

WHEREAS, this program is essential to these otherwise isolat-
13 ed village communities if they are to survive and develop; and

14

WHEREAS, connecting roads will greatly assist in reducing
15 living costs by making possible the transportation of food and
16 other essentials from one point to another by the least expensive
17 means; and

WHEREAS, a connecting road link between Council and Kaltag
19 and intermediate villages in Northwestern Alaska should be a
20 matter of priority in accomplishing the purposes of the Bureau of
21 Indian Affairs road program;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Bureau of Indian Affairs is request-
23 ed to give priority in its road program to the construction of a
24 substantial road system connecting Council, White Mountain,
25 Golovin, Elim, Moses Point, Koyuk, Ungalik, Shaktolik, Unalakleet
26 and Kaltag; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that copies of this resolution be sent to
28 the Honorable Philleo Nash, Commissioner of Indian Affairs, Depart-
29 ment of the Interior; the Honorable Robert L. Bennett, Area

1 Director, and Robert Trier, Chief of Roads Branch, Bureau of
2 Indian Affairs; and the members of the Alaska Delegation in
3 Congress.
