BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs now has an excellent

but modest program through which it provides for drinking water

10

wells for Native villages; and

WHEREAS, this program is of recognized importance to the

12

health and well-being of the residents of these villages; and

13

WHEREAS, the program is not now designed to keep pace with

14

the need for this essential service;

15

BE IT RESOLVED that the Bureau of Indian Affairs is earnestly

16

requested to immediately expand its program for drinking water

17

wells for the villages of Alaska; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that copies of this resolution be sent to

19

the Honorable Stewart L. Udall, Secretary of the Interior; the

20

Honorable Philleo Nash, Commissioner of Indian Affairs; the

21

Honorable Robert L. Bennett, Area Director, Bureau of Indian

Affairs; and the members of the Alaska Delegation in Congress.
