BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

WHEREAS, discoveries made by Alaskan prospectors have yielded

mineral wealth with a present-day value of one and a half billion

dollars and have led to the building of roads, railroads, towns,

and cities, including the Capital City of Juneau; and

WHEREAS, the prospector, through his courage, perseverance,

and defiance of hardship has become the unique symbol of Alaskan

development and romance; and

WHEREAS, the recently announced discovery of a major mine in

the wilderness of Northwestern Alaska proves that undiscovered

mineral wealth remains to reward the diligent prospector;

ficially designate Rhinehart Berg the Prospector of the Year for

1964 in recognition of his discovery and his long devotion to the
