BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

WHEREAS, the National Guard units in the villages of Gambell  
and Savoonga, Alaska are even now obliged to conduct their

training drills in quonset huts erected as temporary facilities

over twenty years ago; and

WHEREAS, a standard village armory in these villages would go  
far to improve the morale, and the standards of recruitment and  
training; and

WHEREAS, such armories would provide much greater safety,

security, and protection for unit equipment;

BE IT RESOLVED that the National Guard Bureau of the Depart-

ment of the Army in the Department of Defense is respectfully

requested to program as soon as possible the necessary funds for

the building of armories at Gambell and Savoonga under the

National Guard Bureau's village armory program.
