5 Supporting federal appropriations for  
6 expanded Coast Guard surface and air  
7 surveillance in Alaskan waters.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

9 WHEREAS the seriousness of the increasing depredations of  
10 foreign fishing fleets in the waters of and off Alaska has been  
11 a cause of serious concern to the people of the state and the  
12 federal government; and

13 WHEREAS the Department of State is supporting requests of the  
14 Department of the Treasury for more funds for Coast Guard vessels  
15 to patrol Alaskan and other waters; and

16 WHEREAS the State of Alaska has a vital concern in increased  
17 surface and air surveillance of foreign fishing operations in the  
18 North Pacific and supports the request for additional money for  
19 that purpose;

20 BE IT RESOLVED that Congress is requested to provide the  
21 Coast Guard with sufficient funds for expanded surface and air  
22 surveillance for the protection of national interests in the North  
23 Pacific; and be it

24 FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be directed to  
25 the Honorable Lyndon B. Johnson, President of the United States;  
26 the Honorable Clarence Cannon, Chairman of the House Appropriations  
27 Committee; the Honorable Carl Hayden, Chairman, Senate Appropria-
