8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

9 WHEREAS, the Senate in 1961 did by the approval of Senate  
10 Resolution No. 27 advise the then Division of Highways now the  
11 Department of Highways that it was the intent of the Legislature  
12 that one million dollars of the highway construction bonds  
13 authorized by the people in 1960 be programmed for survey and  
14 construction of Route S-680, the Fairbanks-Nome Highway; and

15 WHEREAS, the 1961 resolution further requested that work  
16 be begun on both ends of the highway; and

17 WHEREAS, the request is now three years old and the Depart-  
18 ment of Highways has not made any progress on the project;

19 BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully and urgently  
20 requested to direct the Department of Highways to proceed without  
21 further delay to accomplish the necessary programming for and the  
22 construction of Route S-680, the Fairbanks-Nome Highway.
