BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

WHEREAS, the city of Kotzebue is located on federal land

and has federal installations located there; and

WHEREAS, the seawall at Kotzebue is old and almost useless

11

and offers little or no protection against the sea; and

WHEREAS, there is danger to life and property from a storm

13

driven sea until the city is protected by a new seawall;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Corps of Engineers, United States

15

Army, is respectfully urged to construct a seawall at Kotzebue

16

as a protection for the lives and property of the people living

17

there and at the federal installations; and be it

to the Honorable Cyrus R. Vance, Secretary of the Army; the

Honorable Pat McNamara, Chairman, Committee of Public Works;
