BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

WHEREAS, the state vocational school at Nome is now nearing
10 completion; and

WHEREAS, before its regular occupancy for use as a vocational
12 school the facilities will be used to train residents of the
13 Northwestern District under the Manpower Training Act; and

WHEREAS, the schooling offered will attract students from
15 the vast area constituting the Northwestern District and housing
16 facilities for these students is not available in Nome; and

WHEREAS, the success of the school and its programs depends
18 on the number of students from the entire area it can serve;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Bureau of Indian Affairs is requested
20 to move with dispatch to use the money included in the President's
21 Budget for the provision of room and board facilities at the Nome
22 Vocational School; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be sent to
24 the Honorable Stewart L. Udall, Secretary of the Interior; the
25 Honorable Philleo Nash, Commissioner of Indian Affairs; the Hon-
26 orable Robert L. Bennett, Alaska Area Director, Bureau of Indian
27 Affairs, and the member of the Alaska Delegation in Congress.
