8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

9 WHEREAS the recent earthquake and attendant disasters brought  
10 into play the services of a state agency and its volunteer workers  
11 which are not fully appreciated until needed; and

12 WHEREAS the director, employees and the many volunteer workers  
13 assisting in meeting the recent disaster swung into immediate  
14 action within minutes after the first impact of the earthquake  
15 and worked long and tedious hours in carrying out their assigned  
16 and assumed duties to report and provide for the needs of the  
17 people and communities affected; and

18 WHEREAS the merits of the regular and volunteer workers were  
19 particularly meritorious in Anchorage which was the main center of  
20 personal and property damage and loss;

21 BE IT RESOLVED that the Senate does hereby extend the thanks  
22 and commendation of the people of Alaska to the Division of Civil  
23 Defense, its staff and volunteer helpers, for their particularly  
24 meritorious and effective action in meeting the needs of the  
25 people and communities of the state affected by the recent earth-  
26 quake disaster, particularly those who labored so long and so  
27 effectively in the disaster stricken areas of the state.
