5 Expressing appreciation to the
6 military forces in Alaska for
7 their service during and after
8 the recent earthquake disaster.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

10 WHEREAS the recent earthquake disaster which struck the com-
11 munities of southcentral Alaska brought to the fore the importance
12 of the service available to the people and communities concerned
13 from public and private organizations; and

14 WHEREAS the military forces in Alaska provided an outstanding
15 example of service under emergency conditions to provide medical
16 and other assistance while assuming the main burden of maintaining
17 order and protecting property during the recent disaster and the
18 immediate aftermath; and

19 WHEREAS the efficiency and dispatch with which this assistance
20 was provided in response to request from civilian authorities
21 greatly lessened the problems attending the effects of the disas-
22 ter;

23 BE IT RESOLVED that the Senate does hereby extend to the
24 military commanders in Alaska and the officers and personnel work-
25 ing at their direction, including the Adjutant General, officers
26 and men of the Alaska Army and Air National Guard, Civil Air
27 Patrol, and the U. S. Coast Guard, its sincerest thanks and com-
28 mendation for a job well done; and be it
