9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 14.20.170(1) is amended to read:

11 (1) incompetency, which is defined as the ina-  
12 bility or the unintentional or intentional failure to perform  
13 the teacher's customary [ONE'S LEGITIMATE] duties in a  
14 satisfactory manner;

15 \* Sec. 2. AS 14.20.170(2) is repealed and re-enacted to read:

16 (2) immorality, which is defined as the commission  
17 of an act which, under the laws of the state, constitutes a  
18 crime involving moral turpitude;

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
