BE RESTRICTED. No rule or regulation of the commissioner of

education, a local school board, or local school administrator

may restrict or modify the right of a teacher to engage in

comment and criticism outside school hours, relative to

17

school administrators, members of the governing body of any

18

school or school district, any other public official, or any

19

school employee, to the same extent that any private indi-

vidual may exercise the right.
